Fleas

What are fleas?

Fleas are insects that feed on the blood of humans or animals. Some of the more common fleas encountered in our geography include cat fleas, dog fleas, and human fleas. Fleas undergo complete metamorphosis (egg, larva, pupa, adult) and the adult measures about 1/8 inches in length. Fleas are brownish black to black in color, and reddish black, when filled with blood. Larval stage is white eyeless and legless. Female which lays 4 to 8 eggs after each blood meal, may lay up to 500 eggs during her lifetime. Eggs are laid and deposited on or between pet hairs and are consequently easily shaken off into bedding. Adults may live for months without food..



Why do I have them?

They may have been introduced by your pet; however, fleas are good jumpers that can jump up to six inches vertically. You do not have to have a pet in your home for fleas to be introduced, as they can ride in on your pants or shoes. Once introduced to your home they may live for up to six months without feeding.

Are they dangerous?

Fleas inflict uncomfortable bites, and are known to transmit diseases such as plague and murine typhus.

How do you get rid of fleas?

Fleas may be difficult to control that's why our service includes the necessary products and follow up visits for one fee. Our treatment methods consist of the following:
