Stink Bugs

What are Stink Bugs?

The Brown Marmorated Stink Bug is appropriately named because it's capable of emitting an offensive smelling liquid from a gland located in its thorax. Sometimes referred to as a shield bug, stink bugs are typically varying shades of brown and are recognized by a triangular shaped plate on their backs. Adults are a little less than an inch in length, and are almost as wide as they are long.



Are they dangerous?

Even though stink bugs are not harmful to humans and do not reproduce inside homes or other structures, they are considered a nuisance pest when they become active in fall and spring. If many of them are squashed or vacuumed up, their smell can be quite apparent.

How do I get rid of stink bugs?
