EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR CHECKLISTS

To get you and your staff started, we've provided assessment checklists, outlining several conditions that may be considered root causes for pest activity in and around your property.

Exterior structure assessment

Requires corrective action

- o Cracks or holes in the building's structure
- o Gaps around windows and doors
- o Standing water near the building
- o Clogged gutters or downspouts
- o Waste disposal near the building, trash cans or dumpsters that are damaged or uncovered
- o Vegetation or mulch that touches or is within 18" of the building

Requires immediate action

- o Presence of pests (living or dead), nests, or hives
- o Droppings from insects, rodents, birds, or wildlife
- o Evidence of pest burrows, damaged wood, etc.

Interior assessment

Requires corrective action

- o Gaps around doors and windows
- o Cracks or holes in walls and ceiling
- o Food waste or spilled product in undesignated areas
- o Leaks or condensation around plumbing, windows, or HVAC equipment
- o Excessive moisture or humidity in any area
- o Clogged or dirty drains
- o Excessive paper trash, boxes, or clutter (even in storage)

Requires immediate action

- o Presence of pests (living or dead), nests, or hives
- o Droppings from insects or rodents
- o Evidence of gnawed wires, shredded packaging, grease marks along walls, damaged wood, etc.
